- Up to 1500mm blade diameter
- Trench cutting
- Surface and buried chasing for cables
- Relief cutting for break out of damaged bays
- Pavement cutting up to 1.2m thick







Coring / AGL Installation

- Removal of existing AGL
- · Installation of new AGL

- Sealing of concrete bays in pavements using a fuel resistant sealant




